How to find the correct page

If the exact page cannot be found, you can still retrieve the information using the documentation query interface.

Option 1 — Ask a question (recommended)

Perform an HTTP GET request on the documentation index with the ``ask`` parameter, and the optional ``goal`` parameter:

GET https://docs.holybro.com/gps-and-rtk-system/gps-led-and-buzzer/gps-led-and-buzzer-meaning.md?ask=<question>&goal=<goal>
```

``ask`` is the immediate question: it should be specific, self-contained, and written in natural language.
``goal`` is optional and describes the broader end goal you are ultimately trying to accomplish on behalf of the user.

The response will contain a direct answer to the question and relevant excerpts and sources from the documentation.

Option 2 — Browse the documentation index

Use this to discover valid page paths or navigate the documentation structure.

Option 3 — Retrieve the full documentation corpus

Use this to access all content at once and perform your own parsing or retrieval. It will be more expensive.

Tips for requesting documentation

Prefer ``md`` URLs for structured content, append ``md`` to URLs (e.g., ``/gps-and-rtk-system/gps-led-and-buzzer/gps-led-and-buzzer-meaning.md``).

You may also use ``Accept: text/markdown`` header for content negotiation.
